*Detailed Itinerary**

Thursday, April 20

This evening you will depart Los Angeles for Mexico City. After your arrival, you will be welcomed at the airport and brought to your hotel.

Friday, April 21

After Mass at the Metropolitan Cathedral, proceed to the Pyramids of Teotihuacan to see the pagan culture of a mysterious pre-Aztec culture. These pyramids were so massive that Aztecs did not believe they were built by humans, and named this place "the city of the gods". Afterwards, visit the National Museum of Anthropology to understand the Aztec culture. (Possible museum lecture on pre-Christian beliefs of the relation of the gods and humanity). Afterwards, continue to picturesque Zocalo where you will visit the National Palace and the Palace of Fine Arts.

Saturday, April 22

Today we visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe. We tour the Plaza de Tres Culturas, Church of Santiago de Tlalteco, Cerritos Chapel and Tepeyac Hill. Mass will be celebrated in the old Basilica. This full day will be devoted to Our Lady of Guadalupe who brought the people of this country to the doorstep of her divine Son.

Sunday, April 23

After breakfast, we continue our journey of faith, and embark on a road trip to Puebla where we will visit the Church of Santo Domingo, the Church of St. Francis, and celebrate Mass at the Sanctuary of the Virgin of Remedios, which is a beautiful church built on top of the largest pyramid ever discovered. After mass, we proceed to the Basilica of the Virgin of Ocotlan, then visit the Church of San Miguel del Milagro. Free time to shop in Tlaxcala.

Monday, April 24

This morning we start at Coyoacan at the Church of San Juan Bautista. Afterwards, enjoy the scenic beauty and a once-in-a-lifetime trip down the colorful canals of Xochimilco. We then return and climb Tepeyac Hill to celebrate mass at the chapel at the top of the hill, where it is believed that Our Lady appeared to San Juan Diego.

Tuesday, April 25

As we prepare to depart this land of wonder, we visit the Church of the Holy Family. As we meditate on the martyrdom of Blessed Miguel Pio, we will be inspired to a stronger conviction in our faith. On our way to the Village of Our Lady of Guadalupe, we visit the only imperial palace in North America, Chapultepec Castle. Afterwards, we visit the Church of Santiago de Tlalteco, where San Diego was baptized. In that mass, we recall our own baptism and calling to spread the Good News. Then we proceed to the airport to return to Los Angeles, full of memories and new insights into our faith.
